

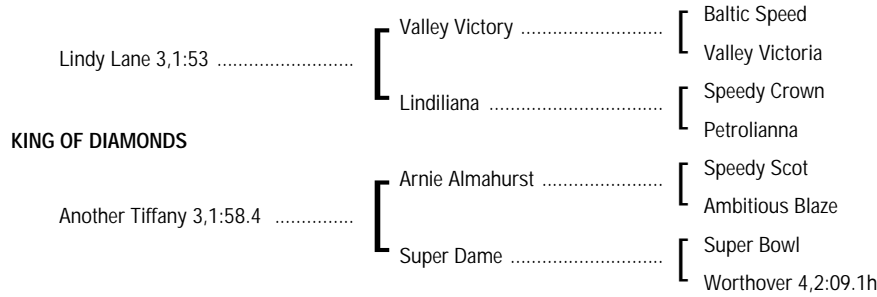

ANOTHER TIFFANY 2,2:00.3; 3,1:58.4 (\$50,605) by Arnie Almahurst. 3 wins. At 2, winner of Merrie Annabelle Trot and heat of Hayes Memorial; second in final of Hayes Memorial; timed in 1:57.3. At 3, second in La Belle Province Trot. From 14 foals, dam of 6 winners (1 in 1:54, 6 in 2:00):

DIAMOND GOAL 2,2:00.4f; 3,1:53.1-1:56f; 4,Q1:54.1f (\$586,074) (h, Armbrø Goal). 17 wins. At 2, undefeated. At 3, 23-7-4-2; earnings of \$343,720; winner \$138,000 heat of Kentucky Futurity, heat of World Trotting Derby (over Cigar Bar, Pegasus Spur, Cobol, Chasing Tail, etc.), \$75,000 NJSS Final at Freehold, Matron S. elim. and NJSS at Freehold; second in final of World Trotting Derby, NJSS, Canadian Trotting Classic cons. (to Pegasus Spur), etc.; third in Zweig Memorial; fourth in \$245,774 Matron S. (timed in 1:55f) and Beacon Course elim. (to S J's Caviar). At 4, winner of \$96,075 Frank Ryan Memorial and an Open at Vernon; set world record for 4-year-old trotters on a 5/8 mile track (winning by 17 lengths); also equaled the all-age trotting record at Pompano Park (set by Mack Lobell in 1987); and tied with Mack Lobell and Georgia Limited (1998) as the second fastest trotter of all-time on a 5/8 mile track. At 5, Open Winner at Vernon Downs; third in \$250,000 final of Classic Series (to Magician). At 6, second in 2 legs of Su Mac Lad Series; third in leg of Classic Series. At 7, winner of an Amateur Trot at The Meadowlands. At 8, second and third in legs of Billings Series.
