**OWNER'S STATEMENT**

This good looking and lightly raced 3-year-old gelding by MUSCLE HILL is unquestionably the best-bred young trotter in the sale. In his last start at time of consignment (June 21), he was second in a qualifier at Gaitway Farms, trotting in 1:56.1. Prior to that, he was second to the good colt DEES RED DELICIOUS 2,1:54.1 (\$264K), timed in 1:57.1f. By leading sire MUSCLE HILL, he is a half-brother to last year's Hambletonian runner-up READY FOR MONI 3,1:51.1 (\$934K), and his second dam is Horse of the Year MONI MAKER 1:52.1 (\$5.5M). Versatile over all sized tracks and bred in the purple, he is a candidate to work his way up the conditioned ladder, and is a chancy prospect with a bright future. With his looks and pedigree, this former \$75,000 yearling purchase could be the buy of the sale as he contains all the ingredients needed to improve for his new connections. Eligible to this year's KYSS, NJSD Fund, NJ Garden State Trot and NJ Trotting Futurity. He will continue to race until the sale-check for important updates.
