In 2021, after qualifying in 1:50 (finishing third to Cattlewash), he has paced in 1:49.1, 1:49.3 and 1:50.2 in his first 3 seasonal starts. Last year, he was a winner of over \$54,000, taking his 1:48 record at Woodbine. He was also a 1:49 winner at The Meadowlands, and sports a wicked 1:48.3-26 performance, finishing third to Tall Dark Stranger (from post 9). In 2020, he was on the board in 10 of 15 starts, pacing in 1:50 or faster in 9 of them! If you judge a horse by the company he keeps, he raced against American History, Western Joe, Highalator, Sintra, Wheels On Fire, Dorsoduro Hanover, Ana Afreet N, Shake That House, The Greek Freak, etc. Simply put, he is one of the top racehorses in the sale. A true professional, he won in 1:50.3f in his only non-mile track start, and shows multiple last quarters of :25.4. He is just getting back into shape, and could be that top-level pacer everyone is looking for.
