A 3-time winner in 2021, he trotted to his lifetime best 3,1:53.4-'21 record winning at The Meadowlands, and shows other good miles in 1:51.4, 1:52.3, 1:53.1, etc. At time of entry, he won handily on Dec 9 over the half at Yonkers in his local debut and his 2021 seasonal summary reads 1-2-3 in 9 of 16 starts (trotting in 1:54.3 or faster in 10 of them). Impeccably bred, he is a FULL brother to World Champion and 2YO & 3YO Trotter of the Year and 1:50 sire FATHER PATRICK 3,1:50.2f (\$2.5M) and 2YO Trotter of the Year and new Indiana sire PASTOR STEPHEN 3,1:52.4 (\$1M). A former \$240,000 yearling purchase, he checks all the boxes going forward. One of the best bred trotters in the sale with potential stallion value after his racing days are behind him. He is a proven performer over all sized tracks while possessing excellent gate speed. This lightly raced youngster has hit the board in over 50% of his 23 career starts and should be a welcome addition to many raceway stables in many jurisdictions within North America and Internationally.
