For: Foals of 2001

To Be Raced As:

Two separate races, the Kentucky Futurity Open Division and the Kentucky Futurity Filly Division.

Estimated Total Purse:

\$400,000E Open Division

\$200,000E Filly Division

To Be Raced At: The Red Mile, Lexington, KY on the mile track during the Fall Grand Circuit meet.

Cancellation:

The Red Mile reserves the right to cancel any or all of the races if it becomes impractical or undesirable in the opinion of The Red Mile to conduct said races. If an event is not raced, The Red Mile's responsibility and liability shall be limited to refunding, without interest, all payments collected toward these events. These monies will be pro-rated among those owners of horses eligible at the time of cancellation.

Added Money:

The association and/or sponsors will add ten percent (10%) to all monies collected from nominations, stakes payments and starting fees for this event. The association may deduct one per cent for administration, advertising and trophies for these events.

Nomination Fees: May 15, 2002; \$25 (US Funds only)

Future Payments: (US Funds only)

Two Year Old Payment

a) Supplemental Payment.....	\$1,000	\$500

a) Those horses not nominated to these events by the yearling payment may be made eligible the two year old supplemental payment of the fees designated herein.

Three Year Old Payments

February 15, 2004.....	\$1,500	\$750
Declaration Fee.....	\$5,000	\$2,000
b) Supplemental Payment.....	\$25,000	\$10,000

b) Ineligible three year olds may be made eligible to the Kentucky Futurity Open & Filly divisions in 2004 with a declaration to start accompanied by payment of a supplemental declaration fee no later than the prescribed time and date determined by The Red Mile. The supplemental declaration fee shall be \$25,000 (US Funds) plus the normal declaration fee for the Open division; the supplemental declaration fee shall be \$10,000 (US Funds) plus the normal declaration fee for the Filly division.

Filly Notice:

A filly eligible to the filly division of the Kentucky Futurity may start in the Open division of the Kentucky Futurity by making up the required Open division payments. Previous payments remain with the Filly division. A filly may not start in both events.

Payment Distribution:

Nomination fees will be divided equally between the two races. All other payments will be credited to the specific race.

Transfer:

Any eligible horse may transfer to the Tattersalls Pace by paying all nomination and other required payments due in the Tattersalls at the time of transfer.

Declaration:

Declaration fee shall be due at the time of declaration and payable before the horse starts. Declaration fees should be made payable to The Red Mile. There are no refunds for scratched horses. Qualifying standards for these events shall be those in effect for Added Money Races at The Red Mile.

Notice:

USTA Rule 11 Sec 3 provides: "Failure to make any payment required by the conditions constitutes an automatic withdrawal from the event."

Racing Conditions:

The Kentucky Futurity Open and Filly divisions shall be raced two heats of one mile each with ten percent (10%) set aside for the race winner. If two separate heat winners, they alone shall return for a third and final heat. If more than sixteen (16) horses declare to start, the race shall be divided into elimination heats with the first five (5) finishers returning for the second heat. If, after the second heat, there have been three different winners, they alone shall return for a third and final heat.

Money Division:

In both the Open and Filly division, ninety percent (90%) of the purse shall be divided and awarded: 50%, 25%, 12%, 8% & 5% according to the finish in each of the heats. Ten percent (10%) of the total purse shall be reserved for the race winner.

Disputes:

Decisions by the Executive Committee of The Red Mile shall govern all disputes arising from these conditions

Rules:

Rules of The Red Mile, Kentucky Racing Commission and the USTA shall govern unless otherwise specified in these conditions.
