



The Red Mile 2003 Detention Rules

1. Horses must be checked into detention area and properly identified by the time designated on the overnight sheet for all detention races. Failure to report by the designated time may result in the scratch of the horse.
2. All persons entering the detention area must have an approved state license and are subject to search/inspection.
3. Horses will be sequestered in the detention area for the amount of time designated by The Red Mile management.
4. Horses in the detention barn will be permitted to exercise on the track at 7:00AM daily. Horses will leave the detention area together and must return by 7:30AM. Horses must remain on the track at all times. Horses may be walked only in the detention area and observed by a Red Mile security guard.
5. Names of not more than three authorized individuals per horse are to be recorded by Red Mile security along with the times that they enter and exit the detention area. The detention area security guard shall obtain an emergency phone contact number from each caretaker or trainer upon logging horses into the detention area. It is suggested that these lists be prepared in advance and submitted to security upon check in.
6. All feed may be checked. No vitamins or additives are permitted to be added to feed or water. Samples of feed and water may be taken at the discretion of The Red Mile.
7. Trainer must provide water bucket, feed tub, cross ties and any equipment necessary to prepare the horse to race.
8. Tongue Ties will be provided by The Red Mile
9. Any liniment not permitted for use in the paddock will not be permitted for use in the detention area. No DMSO or topical freezes are permitted in the detention area.
10. No food or beverages will be permitted in the stalls.
11. No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted in the detention area.
12. No individuals are permitted in the detention barn between the hours of midnight and 6AM daily. Exceptions are in the case of an emergency.
13. Any groom wishing to remain with their horse overnight must have approval from Red Mile security.
14. No veterinarians will be permitted in the detention area with the following exceptions:
 - a) To administer Lasix to horses that require
 - b) Emergency situations
15. To safeguard against improper pre-race administration, such items including but not limited to: drugs, medicants, injectibles, syringes, needles or dose syringes, funnels, tubes, unidentified liquids and powders, shall be confiscated and the KRC and Red Mile security shall be immediately notified.
16. These rules and regulations may be amended at any time at the discretion of The Red Mile.

Any Violation of These Rules May Result in the Scratch of Any Horse in Question, Fines, Suspension and/or Expulsion.
