



THE RED MILE 2003 FALL MEET RACING RULES & POLICIES

1. All personnel must be licensed by the Kentucky Racing Commission for 2003.
2. All personnel will be subject to Kentucky law and all rules and security policies in place while stabled at The Red Mile and/or competing in Red Mile events
3. All horses declared to race must have Electronic Eligibility, a negative Coggins Test within the past 12 months and those declared into claiming races must have a claiming authorization on file in the Racing Office.
4. KRC rules prohibit all race day medication other than Lasix. Lasix will be administered by the veterinarian designated by The Red Mile at the test barn site (Barn #11) at the time prescribed and posted by The Red Mile and the KRC.
5. The Red Mile and KRC prohibit possession of any veterinary medication and/or apparatus to introduce such by anyone other than a licensed veterinarian.
6. Milkshaking and any apparatus to perform milkshaking are prohibited.
7. Any horse declared to race may be tested for any medication or prohibited substance at any time at the discretion of The Red Mile & KRC
8. At the discretion of The Red Mile & KRC, any horse declared to race may be required to be in an assigned stall on the grounds of The Red Mile 24 hours before any race in which that horse is scheduled to participate
9. Any and/or all races may be subject to 24-hour detention at the discretion of The Red Mile.
10. Horses stabled at The Red Mile may not be removed from the grounds on the day they are entered to race.
11. No medication is permitted in the paddock.
12. Qualifying standards for any/all Red Mile Fall 2003 events (overnights, stakes, early or late closers, futurities, etc) or KYSS events will be a charted line with no breaks within in 45 days of the race with the following time standards: 2yo T-2:14) 2yo P-2:12) 3yo T-2:10) 3yo P-2:08)
13. The Red Mile reserves the right to deny stall space, reject any entry, change the program order, place mis-declared horses in correct classes and declare off any race that does not fill.
14. All fees and purses are in US Funds.
15. Applicant agrees to vacate stall and move all horses, equipment and personnel off the premises within 72 hours of notice to do so and within 48 hours of the conclusion of the race meet.
16. These rules & regulations may be amended at any time at the discretion of The Red Mile.

Any Violation of These Rules May Result in the Scratch of Any Horse in Question, Fines, Suspension and/or Expulsion.
