



## General Conditions for Added Money Events

- 1) The condition of all races will comply with the rules and regulations of the K.H.R.C, U.S.T.A and The Red Mile.
- 2) Each event must meet the minimum number of nominations or the event may be cancelled and the monies refunded.
- 3) Those events written to be "separated by sex" may be combined to fill.
- 4) Six (6) separate betting interests are required or the event may be declared off.
- 5) Declarations close in accordance with the current draw schedule at The Red Mile.
- 6) Improperly declared horses may be placed into their proper class.
- 7) All horses must show at least one charted line with no breaks within 45 days race to race meeting the following time standards to be qualified to race in Red Mile Added Money Event.  
2yo Trotters> 2:14 2yo Pacers> 2:12 3yo & Up Trotters>2:10 3yo & Up Pacers> 2:08
- 8) If thirteen (13) or more declare to start, the race may be raced in divisions.  
Efforts will be made to keep the number of trailing horses to a minimum.
- 9) The Red Mile reserves the right to carry any event over one race day.
- 10) All events will be raced one dash at one mile.  
Money division in all Early and Late Closing events shall be 50, 25, 12, 8 & 5 percent.
- 11) Standings toward eligibility for the finals will be money won in series events.
- 12) The nine (9) top money earners in the series that declare will be eligible to the final. If two (2) or more horses are tied for the 9<sup>th</sup> most series money earned, those declared will be drawn by lot to start in the final. In the event the top nine (9) money earners do not declare, declared lower money earners in descending order are eligible to start in the final.
- 13) A minimum of six entries will be necessary to fill a consolation event.
- 14) Non-starters in the series are not eligible for the Final, however horses declared into a race that does not fill shall be recognized as having a start.
- 15) The Red Mile reserves the right to reject any entry and return entry fee, declare off any event if conditions warrant, call off any event not filling satisfactorily and place horses in their eligible class if entered incorrectly.
- 16) If any unforeseeable event prevents the racing of any or all events, monies shall be refunded.
- 17) The Red Mile is not liable and assumes no responsibility for loss by fire, theft or accident of or to persons, animals, equipment or vehicles owned, leased or controlled by any or all of the foregoing. Use of the grounds, track or facilities owned by The Red Mile is at the risk of the party or parties responsible for entries and is assumed by those individuals.
